Bridging Barne Barton


Fotonow is carrying out a social history project in Barne Barton called Bridging Barne Barton: The Island Stories.

Your questions answered

Here are some answers to the questions you have been asking us.

When will regeneration begin and when will I have to move?

The earliest we'll begin regeneration will be the end of this year (2018). We'll let you know as soon as we have a clearer date. We are already working with many of you to start the moving process. How should I leave my home when I move from Barne Barton?

When the time comes for you to move away we need you to clear your home of all your possessions. It has to be empty with no rubbish or furniture left behind. If you have carpet or laminate flooring you can leave this behind. If you have removed any internal doors you don't need to rehang them. Feel free to get in touch if you need us to clarify anything.

Will there be outdoor seating in the new homes for residents without gardens?

We are starting to work out more of the detail for the outdoor areas, including outdoor seating. We'll have more news on how you can get involved in this over the coming months.

I am a Sovereign Housing tenant and I live in the Savage Road block. Why has this block been left out of the regeneration project?

Clarion Housing Group does not own the Sovereign Housing blocks of flats on Savage Road. We will be working with Sovereign to ensure any neighbouring open spaces are well linked and keeping Sovereign residents informed about our plans. We are unable to include these flats in our regeneration project because we do not own them.
